

The Roxy Theatre Bingara

The magnificent Roxy Theatre, situated in the main street of Bingara, is a striking building with a history as colourful as its painted exterior. Built in 1936 by three Greek entrepreneurs, it operated as a cinema until 1958 after which it was closed and lay dormant for forty years.

In May 2004, The Roxy was faithfully restored to its original splendor and was re-opened to the public. The theatre embraces some of the most striking original art deco architecture in New South Wales and still contains the original fixtures and fittings from 1936. Today The Roxy functions as both a multipurpose cinema and regional centre for the performing arts, with The North West Theatre Company taking residence at the Roxy. Dazzling theatrical performances coupled with the building's grand atmosphere makes the Roxy a must see destination.

Meetings and Conferencing

Regionally central to the towns of Inverell, Moree, Tamworth, Narrabri, Gunnedah and Armidale, and offering state of the art meeting and event facilities, The Roxy is an ideal location for your next regional meeting.

The theatre is perfect for large conferences and seats up to 400 people theatre style, whilst the upstairs meeting facility occupies 87sqm and has seating for up to 50 people and includes a screen for multimedia displays, a kitchenette for refreshments and upstairs bathrooms. Smaller breakout rooms are also available. The Roxy Complex is wheelchair friendly.

Perfectly positioned in the heart of Bingara and within walking distance of all major accommodation, the stunning architectural beauty of The Roxy Theatre offers a magical backdrop for a romantic country wedding. It truly is an exceptional venue that provides an unforgettable experience for you and your guests.




Hospitality and Cooking Classes
